Admission Policy

As a small Independent Secondary school, THE BRITISH MUSLIM SCHOOL follows a selective admissions policy. As class sizes are small, places are limited. The following is a guideline of some admissions criteria.

Parents could be from any backgrounds who wishes their child to be educated in a faith school with all the teachings, values and ideologies. For the Muslim parents, it is expected that they complete the five daily Salah, fasting in Ramadhan, paying Zakah and seeking Islamic knowledge themselves. Parents must also observe the societal rules of Islam and respect the values of multi-cultural/faith in Britain.

The school teaches Islam in accordance with the four Madhaab and parents agree to accept this approach.

Parents must agree to support the school ethos and policies. Those involved in the school e.g. current or old staff. Ability of parents to pay fees.

Parents are willing to help regularly in school events and with fundraising efforts.

Additionally each child will be assessed to ensure that entrance into any given year is suitable for his ability. If the child already attends another school, a copy of the latest school report will be required.

ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE

Parents must fill in an application form and their child will be admitted if there is a vacant position, following the entry test, others wise their name shall be added to the waiting list.

At the entry test parents are expected to attend – this will offer an opportunity to see the school and the facilities available. Parents will be provided with the following documents during this visit:
